Window film installer training

Finding the time and money to physically attend business training sessions is not feasible for many tinters. That way, even our most remote tinters have the same access to training as their metro counterparts.

Flat glass exam

Considered a must for anyone involved in the installation and supply of flat glass film, this exam gives you a broad and thorough understanding of the concepts surrounding residential and commercial window film.

Modules include solar energy and heat transfer, glass and glazing systems, solar control and safety and security window film.

Participants must study the Flat Glass Education Guide (included in the cost below), which is posted to you on registration. You can refer to the guide while you take the exam, which is 100 multiple choice questions. Upon payment, you have thirty days to start the exam, and once you start, you have 3 hours to complete it in the one sitting. You will receive a certificate when you pass. WERS For Film training course

As the only accreditation or licensing program in Australia for tinters, WERS For Film accreditation is a must for serious flat glass film installers. This course is a requirement of WERS For Film accreditation, which entitles you to issue energy certificates to your customers and promote yourself as a licensed tinter. Once you register, the training is open for 30 days. In that time, you can log in as many times as you like until it's done. Contact info@wfaanz.org.au to enrol.
